Staunton 351 Delivers Warm Winter Clothing to 79 Pre-Schoolers



With funds from ENF Beacon and Promise Grants, Staunton 351 Community Activities Committee purchased and delivered warm winter coats and hats and sweat suits to seventy-nine Head Start and Pre-School students at Dixon Educational Center in Staunton. The Committee shopped on September 23 for all the



clothing, plus a Snoopy Dog toy and story book. They gathered October 28 at the Lodge and packed the clothing and toy in individual bags labeled for each child. On October 29 they delivered the bags of clothes to each child; the children wanted so much to open their bags, but, for obvious reasons, the staff made them wait until they got home this afternoon to open them. A member of the Dixon staff mentioned

that some of the children were still wearing the sweat suits and coats the Elks distributed last year, albeit they were a little small.
