Greetings to all Staunton Elks Lodge 351 Members:

Earlier this month, District Deputy PER Justine Rieter and I attended the Elks National Convention in Kansas City, Mo. During the convention we attended all required sessions and voted on the business of the Elks Grand Lodge. The resolutions that were discussed and voted on are as follows:

Resolution 2025-01: To make participation in the physical loss and crime coverage policy procured by grand lodge optional for local lodges and require proof of alternative insurance coverage. (Defeated)

Resolution 2025-02: To allow a lodge to satisfy the bond requirement for the Lodge Secretary through an outside insurance company. (Defeated)

Resolution 2025-03: To allow a Lodge to satisfy the bond of requirement for the Lodge Treasurer through an outside insurance company. (Defeated)

Resolution 2025-04: To authorized the issuance of electronic membership cards, allow the Office of the Grand Secretary to determine requirements, and require Local Lodges to recognize an electronic membership card in the same manner as paper cards. (Approved)

Resolution 2025-05: To define what constitutes a lodge Affiliate. (Approved)

Resolution 2025-06: To clarify the suspension of the social privileges of a member applies to all privileges. (Approved)

Resolution 2025-07: To clarify, if a Local Lodge adds the Secretary and Treasurer to the Board of Directors, the Lodge must ensure such actions is consistent with its corporate documents.

*Should any member have questions on the above defeated or approved resolutions please see me and I will be glad to try and explain to you in more detail.




